Division/Department Routing for Organizational Approval

When new studies are submitted for IRB review, the IRB requires the initial application be certified by the Principal Investigator followed by the Division and Department Head(s) represented by the faculty listed in *Section 1 General Information items B.1 and B.3* of the application. The Division Head(s) may first certify or reject the study, followed by the Department Head(s). If rejected by either, the study is routed back to the PI.

Initial Submission Completed > PI Certification > Division Head(s) Certification > Department Head(s) Certification > Study Received by IRB Office

While pending with either Division or Department Head(s), the study will be labeled as "Awaiting Approval". The Approvals tab within the Submission Details page populates with whom the study is currently pending as the study is routed following the below organizational chart. Once all required approvers have certified the study, it is routed to the IRB office for pre-review. **Only one approver is required for study certification for each Department/Division listed, even if two names are provided.
